Hands - on Training for Governmental Specialists

Objectives:

1. The Low Emission and Capacity Building Project (LECB) has developed a Mitigation Action Database to help in collecting as much as possible information on mitigation potential in different sector to support the preparation of national reports and decision making
2. The training aims to raise the capacity of the governmental stakeholders relevant to the mitigation action potentials and populate available data into the Mitigation Actions Database.
3. The database will be populated based on studies developed by the LECB Project in addition to any other updated information (provided by stakeholders and/or national reports) related to GHG emissions mitigation actions.
4. Day 1 of the training will cover data entry for mitigation actions in energy related sectors (Power Generation, Renewable Energy, Transport and Industry), while day 2 will cover data entry for mitigation actions related to Waste and Agriculture Sectors.
5. Follow up with project team and consultant will continue for one month after the training to provide support if needed.
6. A joint workshop/one-day seminar will be organized to present the populated Mitigation Actions Database for Governmental stakeholders (expected in April).
